We the people never consent and did not delegate authority to the government to violate the rights of the people with unconstitutional statutes made for the petrochemical, pharmaceutical and prison industries where the legislature failed to recognize our natural born God given inalienable rights of we the people as has been exercised for over 5000 years to cultivate and use marijuana for food, medicine and religion as part of our cultural heritage as a right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. Whenever the government's statutes become abusive and destructive of the peoples' rights it is the right of the people to alter or abolish the statutes and hold our elected officials responsible for their crimes against the peoples' rights. A statute that gives police power to invade our homes to arrest and steal our property is total tyranny and unfit to govern a free people and totally unconstitutional. Marijuana statutes and New York State government officials violate 1st, 4th, 6th, 8th, 9th, and 10th Amendments to the U.S. Constitution and section 1, 3, 5, 7, 11, 12 and 14 of Article 1; Bill of rights, New York State Constitution. The legislature has imposed and extended an unwarrantable jurisdiction over us threw enforcement of unconstitutional marijuana statues.
